### MONITORING DATES 8/23/2020-5/15/2021

The twenty hours per week limitation is monitored on an academic year basis of 680 hours. This hourly limitation is based on State of Iowa law. Twenty hours per week is allowed with an additional 20 hours factored in for Thanksgiving and Spring breaks\*. Winter break hours (12/13/2020 - 1/23/2021) are excluded. The monitoring dates will vary each year depending on the academic calendar and biweekly payroll schedule.

\*Spring Break 2021 – Due to changes in the academic calendar, these will be instructional days and student employees will be limited to twenty hours of work that week.

This reduces the maximum number of hours to 660 hours for the 20-21 academic year.

## **BIWEEKLY STUDENT SUMMER APPOINTMENT (Non-UI student)**

This section applies only to individuals who are not a registered UI student during the prior spring or current summer but are enrolled and attending college or high school. Forty hours per week is permitted. Departments must complete a P & S Temporary Appointment using a PZ07 temporary employee – Non-UI Student option. # **BIWEEKLY CONTINUOUS APPOINTMENT**

The biweekly continuous appointment requires a begin date within the period of enrollment. To be employed under biweekly continuous in the summer, the individual must be a registered UI student for the prior spring or the current summer. To be employed under biweekly continuous during the winter break period, the individual must be a registered UI student for the prior fall.

#### INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS
