

## 2023-2024 TEACH GRANT APPLICATION

The TEACH Grant provides up to a maximum yearly amount of \$4,000 in grants to students who agree to serve as full-time teachers in a high-need teaching field at a low-income public or private school or education service agency. Currently, the maximum is slightly less than \$4,000 due to federal sequestration.

IMPORTANT: If the service commitment is not fulfilled, the grant will permanently be converted to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan, which must be repaid with interest. Interest will accrue retroactively from the time that each grant disbursed.
