
Scholarships for incoming students

Office of Admissions

- Automatically awarded to students at the time of admission
- Awarded on a rolling basis from October to March
- Eligibility based on high school GPA and test scores (ACT, SAT)
- Awarded for eight semesters or until bachelor's degree conferred, whichever comes first.
- Renewal requires maintaining full-time enrollment and required UI cumulative GPA which varies by scholarship

Student Financial Aid (OSFA)

- Students are automatically considered for a need-based scholarship by filing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Must file FAFSA by priority date set by OSFA
- Eligibility based on having financial need and merit (GPA and test score)
- Must apply by priority date each year (FAFSA) and meet financial need and academic criteria for continued awarding.

Scholarship Information

Scholarships are usually merit-based, recognizing outstanding academic achievement and other accomplishments. Some may require financial need based on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Scholarships are available from many sources:

The University of Iowa Office of Student Financial Aid

You should file the FAFSA after October 1st each year to be considered for need-based scholarships. The 2019-2020 FAFSA filing priority deadline was December 1, 2018. You'll automatically be considered for scholarships if you qualify. Scholarships may be renewed each year if you meet renewal requirements.

The University of Iowa Office of Admissions

The Office of Admissions has scholarships available for first-year, transfer, and international students. You'll automatically be considered for some scholarships and others require a separate application.

Scholarship Renewals and Appeals for Currently Enrolled Students

Renewals and Appeals

Scholarships awarded by the Office of Student Financial Aid and the Office of Admissions require continuous full-time enrollment (12+ hours for each semester) and a specific UI cumulative GPA (not overall cumulative). The GPA requirement differs for each scholarship. Scholarship renewal requirements are renewed each semester and if you do not meet the renewal requirements at the end of a semester, the scholarship will be canceled for all future semesters.

You may experience extenuating circumstances that affect your ability to meet the renewal requirements and may submit an appeal if these circumstances occurred within the semester or academic year. Approving an additional appeal is generally not an option if a previous appeal was already approved.

Reasons for an appeal may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Serious medical condition (illness, surgery, hospitalization, mental health issue, accident) or of an immediate family member
- Death of a family member or close friend
- Assault
- Other circumstances that go beyond your control

Submitting your appeal

If you were notified that your scholarship was canceled and you have experienced any of the above circumstances, send an email to adm_appeals@uiowa.edu. In your appeal, please provide:

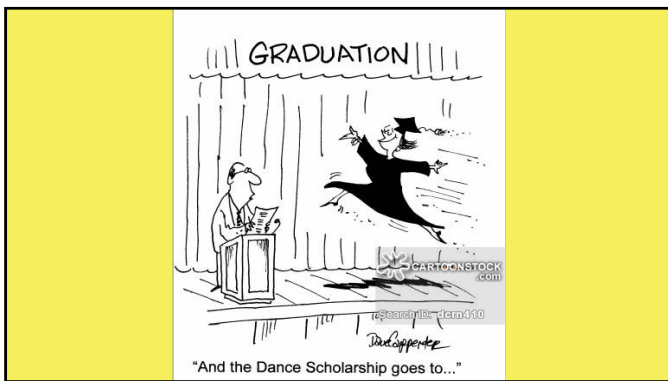
Renewal Requirements

Review Applicants


- Assign committee members to review and rate applicants online and monitor the status of your committee reviewers.

- Data can be exported via an Excel spreadsheet.



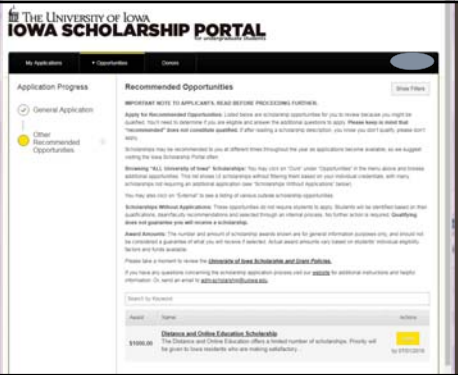


Sign-in page using Hawk ID and password
